

Warm greetings in the name of our **BLESSED** & soon coming **KING, JESUS CHRIST. IT IS WELL WITH MY SOUL.** I pray that in the midst of a crazy world, and our beloved America descending into a pit of perversion, wickedness & godlessness with meteoric speed, it is nonetheless also well with your soul.

Satan, through his seed the Antichrist, wants to rule the world from the Temple Mount, but **GOD** has decreed in the context of the end of the age, "Yet have I set **MY KING** upon **MY** Holy Hill of Zion." I also get requests in the mail from inmates who heard me preach at different prisons that ask for several copies of the Arsenal Prayer to give to others in that prison. It is **ALL** scriptural & very powerful. Why? **ALL GOD'S WORD**. (Heb. 4:12).

The Fred Jordan Mission services have really grown since the new time change. The renovation looks great. Mrs. Jordan & son Tom are going to honor me with a plaque at the Easter feeding. It is a **BLESSING!** Mrs. Jordan had me start a Bible Study for the men in the Spiritual growth program on Spiritual Warfare over 16 years ago. The other mission services were all strong in the **LORD** & attentive, especially the Union Rescue Mission men's & women's services. The L.A. Co. Jail services & counseling this month had many breakthroughs, deliverances & large harvests. Every service is an hour & a half of preaching & they want more. The Chino Women's service is **ALWAYS** packed with over 150 women. I always look forward to ministering there. My 29 year home Bible Study has been growing in number. There were also a large number of calls for prayer & other small groups that I didn't count this month, but **ALL** are important to **GOD**. Remember, every time you talk to someone about Jesus Christ & Salvation, it is put in a Book of Remembrance. (Mal, 3:16).

Question: What does **GOD MOST** require of you? Is it love? Worship? Obedience? Surprise!!! What **GOD**

wants from us is humility. That means to put **OTHERS FIRST**. The definition is simple, the action difficult. We live in a "me-first" society, very competitive, that often sees humility as a sign of weakness. I, me & my, is the Un-holy trinity. Was **JESUS** weak? Of course not! Yet, **HIS** life was the ultimate example of humility. He is the **KING OF KINGS** (Rev. 19:16), yet **HE** humbled **HIMSELF** to be born in a stable, & to be a servant. (Matt. 20:28; Mk. 10:45). He even died on the cross for you & me, the most shameful death possible in **HIS** day.

The truth is, **GOD** is far more interested in your humility than in your greatest accomplishments. After all, everything else in our spiritual life flows from it. Our compassion, kindness, gentleness & forgiveness are all affected by humility. Even our spiritual life depends on humility for if we do **NOT** surrender our will, **JESUS** cannot be **LORD** of our life. The opposite of humility is **PRIDE**. Scripture tells us **GOD** detests pride, in fact, Prov. 16:5 calls it "an abomination to the **LORD**." When we are proud, we are defying the sovereignty of **GOD** by exalting ourselves above **HIM**. (Jas. 4:6; I Peter 5:5; Prov. 16:18). Before you & I can become truly humble, we must be willing to deal with specific areas of pride in our lives. In fact, I identified 7 key areas we are to examine:

- 1) Your possessions — Are they an area of pride? Be honest.
- 2) Your position — Don't bask in your high positions. **GOD** is the **ONE** who gave it to you. (Jas. 1:17).
- 3) Your appearance — Attack this area of pride by looking for the good features in others. **GOD** made us.
- 4) Your knowledge — No matter if you are an expert let others speak... You might learn something.
- 5) Your achievements & awards — Recognize & reward those who helped you get where you are. Amen!
- 6) Your gifts & talents — Find someone less talented; encourage, nurture & help them grow. **PRAISE HIM!!!**
- 7) Your response to **GOD'S** will — Pride can block you from doing what **GOD** asks of you — & experiencing the joy of living, within **HIS PERFECT WILL**. Seek **HIS** will **DAILY**.

Beloved, in the months to come, I urge you to follow the call of I Peter 5:6 to "humble yourselves under the mighty hand of **GOD** that **HE** may exalt you at the proper time."
