

GRACE & PEACE to each of you from GOD our FATHER & our LORD JESUS CHRIST, our soon coming KING. I trust that in spite of any troubles, adversities or afflictions (Ps. 34:19) you may be experiencing, you can still shout ìPRAISE THE LORDî (Ps. 18:3; Ps. 50:23; Ps. 34:1). That is how we enter HIS throne room, with PRAISE, WORSHIP & THANKSGIVING. I love Ps. 92:1, 2 ìIt is good to give THANKS to the LORD, & to sing PRAISES to YOUR name, Oí MOST HIGH, to declare YOUR LOVINGKINDNESS in the morning & YOUR FAITHFULNESS by night.î I spend a great deal of time PRAISING the LORD DAILY! A.M. & P.M!

I PRAISE HIM for the supernatural strength & divine energy HE gave me this month of September where I did 37 services. The HOLY SPIRIT brought in a harvest of well over 500. It was such a blessed month of ministry & also one under great warfare because of the WORD going forth & large harvests in enemy territory---but I John 4:4 says, ìGreater is HE that is IN me, than he that is in the world.î P.T.L. No matter how severe the pain in my body, I press on in HIS strength & power. (Eph. 6:10; John 15:5, Phil. 4:13) Here is a scripture sent by an inmate that I ministered to in a penitentiary for 7 years. He is released & doing well today serving the LORD. He prays his Arsenal prayer DAILY. This is from the ìWAYÍŠ Translationî. It is a powerful translation of I. Cor. 15:57: ìVery human as I am, I do not fight with merely human weapons. No, the weapons with which I war are not the weapons of the senses, but in the STRENGTH of GOD, they are mighty enough to raze all strongholds of the foe. I can batter down the bulwarks of human reason. I can scale every craggy fortress that towers up bidding defiance to the true knowledge of GOD.î Yes, we are in a war with an unseen foe (II. Cor.10:3), but he is defeated & his end is written. P.T.L. However, even though the devils time is short, we must continue to serve & win souls in these dark days. JESUS Himself says in Luke 9:23, ìIf anyone wishes to come after ME, let him deny himself, & take up his CROSS daily & follow Me.

My 12-day ministry trip to WA. & Or. was a most incredible time of ministry & harvesting souls. GODÍŠ WORD went forth like a laser piercing the darkness. We were in some dark places, but PRAISE GOD, we were never alone. (Heb. 13:5; Matt. 28:20; Deu. 31:6) Helen & Bob Hagan again blessed me in so many ways. They treat me like family. I could not have gone on this 12-day trip had they not invited me to stay in their home for the 6th time. Bob is an anointed brother, especially in his praise & worship singing & playing the piano. I flew in on Wednesday afternoon & preached the evening service at Walla-Walla Penitentiary Maximum Security. Many who came attended my services in the past years. On Thursday we went back to Walla-Walla to the WSP unit & we had the largest number in attendance during the 6 years that I came there to minister.

Friday was a long day. There were 3 services at the Benton Co. Jail. The ones who attended all got the Arsenal Prayer & 90% prayed the sinnersí prayer. That night I was at the Faith Innkeepers Mission where most there are in recovery. There were several who heard me minister to them at Coyote Ridge Prison. Saturday the 1st & Saturday the 8th was the Day Springs Ministry T.V. show & the local T.B.N. show. The 8th was for the Christ-mas shows. The music group played & sang worship songs (Christmas songs on the 8th) & introduced me. I then look into the camera & give my message. Sunday was an off day to celebrate Helenís birthday. I needed a day of rest. I had ministered at 20 services in 28 days before I came to Kennewick, WA.

On Monday the 3rd we went to Coyote Ridge & had a large number & harvest at the service. Tuesday took me to Two Rivers Prison where I was fingerprinted to get my Oregon badge for ministering. Now Iíll be able to go to prisons near my daughter Lea in Portland. Oregon State Pen. & 3 others are within an hour or so from Portland. That night we had 2 services & again, many greeted & remembered me. The harvest was huge. Wednesday the 5th took me back to Benton Co. Jail for 2 services with Brother Levi, & back to Walla-Walla that night. We were on a role. The anointing was strong & everything opened up. NO LOCKDOWNS. On Thursday the 6th, I was interviewed for a magazine (2 hours) & went to Umatilla that night. Friday was great! At the Eastern Oregon Pen., the chapel was packed & when we had them say ìPRAISE the LORDî, they rocked the facility. On Sunday, I was at the Highway Tabernacle Church for

Pastor Wetmore, a precious brother in the Lord. Afterwards Bob, Ron & I walked the tiers for 2 hours & then I ministered at the MSC unit Walla-Walla for my last service. My sermons are geared to encourage, edify, & uplift the downtrodden & lost. I also expose the adversary, our enemy, with scripture, giving each one the Warfare Arsenal prayer for them to STAND against the wiles of the devil. Amazing things are happening as the HOLY SPIRIT moves on them.

I flew home Monday the 10th & for the rest of the month I had services at the Skid Row Missions along with Chino Womenís Services & 6 hours at L.A. Co. Jail the 3rd Friday. It was the busiest month Iíve had in 25 years, but a most fruitful & blessed time. I appreciated ALL of your prayers this month. I needed them!!!
