

Greetings in the name of **JESUS CHRIST** “the name that is above **ALL** names & **ALL** things, on the earth, beneath the earth & above the earth.” (Phil. 2:9). There were 18 services in September and 5 others were cancelled. It is frustrating when I drive a long way & I'm told “lockdown.” Had a great weekend of ministry at Chuckawalla Penitentiary. (The inmates call it “Chucky's House,” after the evil doll movie.) Chaplain Bill Carter, who does an excellent job, called me & said inmates who had been transferred from other prisons and had heard me preach asked if I would come to do chapel services. After a 4 hour drive, I did a 1½ hr. service & then 4 services the next day. I drove back home that evening. It was a long but fruitful weekend with very nice harvests at different yards. At L.A. Co., there were 2 lockdowns so I only got to do 1 service out of 3.

Chino Women's Prison made up for it. As always, a large number of inmates came to the chapel service & we had a wonderful harvest of souls. The Skid Row Mission services have had larger crowds than usual. We had 2 weeks of over 100 degree heat so all of the fans were on. There were also more than the usual requests for prayer this month. In my home Bible Study at Gloria Muscarella's, we have many powerful prayer warriors. I always say that prayer is such a privilege & when we say, “**FATHER**, I come to You in the name of **JESUS**,” we are right in **HIS THRONE ROOM**. **GOD** hears **EVERY** prayer of the believer (Prov. 15:29). I always pray before & after my services. The **HOLY SPIRIT** (John 6:44) brought in over 350 who prayed the Sinner's Prayer this month. Even when one comes forward, the angels are singing & rejoicing (Luke 15:10). I also had 3 counseling sessions & many more on the telephone.

It was a blessing this month for me to spend a week in Maui, Hawaii. My friend Ron Zaucha of Lighthouse Prison Ministry gave me a week at a condo that he owns there at no charge. At Alaska Air, I had a lot of mileage & it cost \$5 to get there. **GOD** gives me favor. I was able to write 2 sermons, get refreshed & a nice tan.

Speaking of prayer, we should **DAILY** pray for our family, our country; our armed forces; the peace of Jerusalem (Ps. 122:6); our brothers & sisters in Christ (Eph. 6:18). Prayerlessness is powerlessness. Some use prayer as a formality. Zip, zip & zip. The blood that **JESUS** shed for us removes sin that builds a barrier to prayer. We need a renewed emphasis on prayer! Millions pray **ONLY** in times of great need, stress, danger or uncertainty. I Thess. 5:17 clearly says “praying always.” **JESUS** knew how to pray & was **NEVER** too hurried to pray. What about you? How much time do you spend in prayer? In praise? In worship? We should **NOT** pray quickly & carelessly. We all need a prayer program. **JESUS** prayed more than anyone I ever met & **HE** didn't have to confess sin like I do. **HE** was perfect! Yes, it takes perseverance & persistence but it is the most important thing we can do for one another and ourselves.

I have scores who pray for me. Yes, I need other's prayer & covet them. We must meet with **GOD** alone, regularly, quietly & bare our soul to **HIM** as we come to the Mercy Seat. We should pray **FROM** victory, not **FOR** victory. We always have the victory with **JESUS'** crushing satan at the Cross of Calvary. In every sermon I preach, I use Luke 18:1, “Don't give up, keep on praying.” (II Cor. 4:16 “Don't lose heart, keep on praying.” And we should never give up praying others into the kingdom. One that I prayed for came to the **LORD** after 30 years. Praise **GOD!** Some use petty petitions, repetitions, & works of others. I encourage them to let **GOD** hear the cries of their innermost being. (Ps.34:6, 15, 17) We insult **GOD** when our hearts are far away & we speak with our lips. (Isa. 29:13). In Luke 6:28 & Matt.5:44 it tells us we are to pray for our enemies. We are to pray for & to **GOD'S** will, which is doable. In Romans 8:26, the **HOLY SPIRIT** prays for the believer as does **JESUS**, (Rom. 8:27). Can we do less? **JESUS** is the way, the truth & the life (John 14:6).

We must pray believing & trusting, not allowing doubt to come in. How can we doubt **GOD'S** promise? (II Cor. 1:20). **PRAY!!!**
